
The main cover of an eBook is always considered important because it helps to build a first positive impression about the book. Some of the main reasons why designers pay high attention to eBook covers are:

- What type of genre eBook has and whether it has a established style or not?
- Who will be the readers of this eBook or describe the target audience?
- How much lengthy the eBook will be?
- Does the eBook includes real world events or it has a theoretical story?
- Which type of pictures and visual content will be used in the eBook?

Understand the Elements of a Cover

- Color theme of the eBook cover.
- Typography of the content used on front cover.
- Images and art used in the cover design.
- Overall formatting style of the eBook cover.

Step 4. eBook Cover Design Size

It is also very important to have a proper understanding of the size of eBook covers. A lot of times, designers do not know about this basic fact, which is why they create covers with inappropriate sizes. Generally, the standard size of an eBook cover starts from **1500** to **1800** pixels. These dimensions can change a bit depending on your custom requirements.

If you will look at the recommended height/width ratio of Kindle Direct Publishing (KDP), you'll notice that the platform suggests a ratio of **1:1:6**. The format suggested for eBook covers are **TIFF** and **JPEG**, while **DPI** size is recommended to be **300 DPI**

Step 5:

Choose Graphics, Fonts and Colors

Next up, you need to choose the graphics, fonts and colors very wisely for the eBook cover. As defined earlier, all of these things are key elements of cover designing. They should be picked carefully keeping in view the core theme of the eBook cover design. Some important points you need to remember while selecting them are:

- Colors combination should be picked keeping the genre of eBook in mind.
- The font family should be bold and it should highlight the content strongly.
- Try to use minimum graphical content or particular shape/art for the covers.
- Keep a perfect whitespace balance between all the elements, so that the design looks clean.

Step 6:

Create an eBook Cover Design

Now that you have understood all the important points, lets start designing the eBook cover. In this phase, you will need to use all the technical and analytical expertise to create a catchy design. It is best recommended to work with a picture in mind that is your actual inspiration. This will help you to get correct ideas that fits suitable for eBook cover designing.

Meanwhile, also remember to check the designs of competitors while designing the eBook cover. This technique is pretty helpful, as it lets you know what type of covers others are designing. It will assist you to bring some uniqueness in the design, so that your eBook cover can get an exceptional look.

Stelle Feedback


